
Government Notice No. 103 of 2020

THE LIGHT RAIL ACT 2019

**Regulations made by the Minister under section 45A
of the Light Rail Act 2019**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Light Rail (COVID-19 Sanitary Measures) (Amendment) Regulations 2020.
2. In these regulations –
“principal regulations” means the Light Rail (COVID-19 Sanitary Measures) Regulations 2020.
3. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the definition of “Work Access Permit”, the semicolon at the end of the definition of “senior citizen” being deleted and replaced by a full stop.
4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended –
 - (a) in paragraph (1)(a), by deleting the word “mask” and replacing it by the words “mask over his mouth and nose”;
 - (b) in paragraph (2)(a), by deleting the word “mask” and replacing it by the words “mask over his mouth and nose”.
5. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations is revoked and replaced by the following regulation –

5. Restrictions on travelling

- (1) Subject to paragraph (2), no senior citizen shall travel in a light rail during the peak hours of 06h00 to 10h00 and 14h30 to 19h00 on week days.

(2) Paragraph (1) shall not apply to a senior citizen who travels in a light rail for the purpose of –

- (a) attending work; or
- (b) availing himself of medical treatment or procuring medicine.

- 6. The principal regulations are amended by revoking the Schedule.
- 7. These regulations shall come into operation on 30 May 2020.
