## THE CONSUMER PROTECTION (PRICE AND SUPPLIES CONTROL) ACT

## Regulations made by the Minister under section 35 of the Consumer Protection (Price and Supplies Control) Act

- **1.** These regulations may be cited as the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) (Amendment) Regulations 2021.
- 2. In these regulations
  - "principal regulations" means the Consumer Protection (Control of Imports) Regulations 2017.
- **3.** Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate alphabetical order, the following new definitions, the full stop at the end of the definition of "value" being deleted and replaced by a semicolon
  - "private health institution" has the same meaning as in the Private Health Institutions Act;
  - "registered medical practitioner" has the same meaning as in the Medical Council Act;
  - "registered nurse" has the same meaning as in the Nursing Council Act;
  - "wholesale pharmacy" has the same meaning as in the Pharmacy Act.
- **4.** The Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by inserting, in the appropriate numerical order, the following new items and their corresponding entries –

3822.00.20	COVID-19 Home Self-Testing Kit

**5.** The Sixth Schedule to the principal regulations is amended by adding the following new item and its corresponding entries –
