THE INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS AND CONFERENCES (PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES) ACT

Regulations made by the Minister under section 19 of the International Organisations and Conferences (Privileges and Immunities) Act

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Eastern and Southern African Trade and Development Bank (PTA Bank) (Privileges and Immunities) (Amendment) Regulations 2021.
- 2. In these regulations
 - "principal regulations" means the Eastern and Southern African Trade and Development Bank (PTA Bank) (Privileges and Immunities) Regulations 2013.
- **3.** Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is amended by deleting the word "Schedule" and replacing it by the words "First Schedule".
- **4.** The principal regulations are amended by inserting, after regulation 5, the following new regulation
 - **5A**. A regional office, representative office, branch office, agency, subsidiary, fund or joint venture of the Bank listed in the Second Schedule shall
 - (a) be an international organisation in respect of which Part V of the Act applies; and
 - (b) have and enjoy the inviolability, exemptions, facilities, privileges and immunities under these regulations.
- **5.** The Schedule to the principal regulations is amended, in the heading, by deleting the word "SCHEDULE" and replacing it by the words "FIRST SCHEDULE".

6. The principal regulations are amended by adding the Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.
